

- That objective will be accomplished by growing participation in Climate KIC of city and regional authorities, small and large companies, universities and research bodies.

RIS 3 STRATEGY


- IVACE is also responsible for the Research Innovation Strategies exercise in the region and has produced its RIS3 Matrix
- This matrix of priorities states and emphasizes climate change and sustainability criteria as cross-cutting and common to its three priority axes: Quality of life (tourism, agrofood & health), Innovative Products (consumer goods, life style) and New Advanced Industrial Processes (manufacturing & automotion)
- Energy and environmental technologies are a priority within the technological specialization fields of our RIS3
- The specific objectives set for those technologies are fully in line with the concerns and objectives of Climate KIC.
- The Valencian RIC is destined to play a major role in ensuring the achievement of those objectives by the direct, ever growing action being taken in Climate KIC projects.



















How: Action guidelines

- Consolidation of activities developed until present.
- Establishment of bilateral links with outreach partner regions encouraging coordination and synergies between the EEN facilities and operators.
- Increase of capacity: Direct involvement of Valencian partner universities in the creation of professional education EIT labelled offerings, further involvement of Valencian EBN BIC's in green entrepreneurship incubation, securing presence at a growing number of regional innovation events and ensuring high attendance at the annual Climate-KIC Innovation festivals – next one to take place in Valencia-
- Collaboration with other KIC's: The built environment is an area where collaboration with the other two KIC's is envisaged. The Valencian RIC is particularly strong in this area in complementarity and synergism with partners such as IVE and AIDICO.
- Furthermore, participation in future KIC's is currently being encouraged and supported by IVACE and FCVRE. Should those proposal succeed, RIC Valencia will be in a privileged position for collaboration.









How: Contribution to Climate KIC Business Plan

- The Valencian Ecosystem (all pre-existing climate change related initiatives) is being gradually contributed into Climate KIC activities and projects.
- The pillars of <u>Climate KIC</u> coincide with those of the Region in <u>fostering innovation and IVACE</u>, as the regional authority to implement fostering innovation policies has an average annual <u>budget of 66 M € which is mostly ERDF and ESF cofunded and destined to subsidies to companies and entities</u>.
- More precisely, within the <u>Spanish Framework for Renewable Energies for the period 2011-2020 which implements U.E. directive 2009/28</u>, the Valencian Regional Government will issue, through IVACE, annual <u>public calls for the benefit of sme's and entities.</u>
- This implies, for the period <u>2011-2020</u>, the alignment of <u>ERDF</u> funding of our Operational Programme with Climate KIC funds.
 Thus complementary funding of Climate KIC projects required by EIT is mostly guaranteed.


- Innovation projectslaunched: 24

- e.g.: The Less Competition, a challenge led contest encouraging further C02 emission reduction technologies at supermarkets, such as air conditioning and lighting.
















